

NMC Music Therapy Initiative - New Applicant Guidelines

The **NMC Music Therapy Initiative** is a national program expanding access to professional music therapy services in healthcare and community settings across Canada.

Who Can Apply?

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a Canadian healthcare organization (public or private)
- Have charitable or non-profit status
- Be located in Canada, in a location where no NMC Music Therapy Initiative site currently exists
- Have a connection with a certified music therapist (MTA) or be willing to post an open call to recruit one

Funding Model

Local Site Match (Required):

Each approved site must fund a portion of the program. A **matching contribution of equal value** is required to receive support from the National Music Centre.

National Music Centre Match:

The National Music Centre will match the local site's contribution, **up to \$25,000** per year. This match is funded through donations made to the Music Therapy Initiative and is further supported by a **dollar-for-dollar** contribution from the Jim Pattison Foundation.

Application Process

There is a two-step application process:

1. Step 1 – Initial Online Intake Form:

This short form functions as an *expression of interest* and allows NMC to assess your site's readiness, eligibility, and alignment with program goals.

Note: A proposed program budget and confirmation of matching funds from the local foundation are required at this stage.

2. Step 2 – Full Application (by invitation):

If your intake submission is successful, you will be invited to complete the full application, including additional documentation and financial officer sign-off.

Important: While there are two annual intake deadlines, each applicant may only receive funding once per calendar year.

Applicants who are unsuccessful may reapply in a later intake within the same year.

Application Deadlines & Funding Schedule

For New Applicants

- **December 1** → Decision by **January 30** → Funds disbursed in the **Spring**
- **June 1** \rightarrow Decision by **July 30** \rightarrow Funds disbursed in the **Fall**

For Renewal Applicants

- Funding Disbursement: Annually, on the anniversary of the original disbursement (Spring or Fall)
 - o Payments may be made in one installment or split into two installments (Fall and Spring), depending on the agreement.

- Renewal Requirement: Submit a Renewal Application and Annual Financial and Narrative Report three months prior to the disbursement date
 - December 1 for Spring disbursement
 - June 1 for Fall disbursement

Reporting Requirements

All funded sites must submit:

1. Annual Financial and Narrative Reporting

Submit the Annual Financial Report (template provided) and the Narrative Report

- a. Annual Financial Report (template provided) must include:
 - i. Total funds received (NMC match + local match)
 - ii. Confirmed matched contributions
 - iii. Other secured or pending grants
 - iv. Remaining funds and rollover/reallocation plan
 - v. Signed confirmation from the foundation's financial officer
- b. Narrative Report must include:
 - i. Key activities and outcomes
 - ii. Challenges and successes
 - iii. Supporting documentation as required
- 2. Monthly Clinical Reports
 - a. Submitted by the music therapist via the music therapist's reporting portal
 - b. Data supports quarterly and annual impact reports for NMC

How to Apply

Fill out the Application Form to complete the initial online intake. Be prepared to include:

- A description of your organization and proposed program
- Estimated music therapy hours per week and hourly rate
- Total program cost and proposed budget
- Confirmed local matching contribution
- Requested NMC match (up to \$25,000/year)

If selected, you will be invited to complete the full application with supporting documentation.

Additional Notes

- Each site must host at least one local donor or public awareness event per year
- All media, testimonials, and data must comply with the NMC permissions protocol
 - A consent form will be emailed to successful applicants and must be signed prior to sharing any participant media
- Online music therapy programs are currently under review for future funding eligibility
